We will be only be issuing 100 tickets per performance above, which is exactly 2 tickets per family. Tickets can only be booked using parent pay - we will not be issuing any paper tickets. Tickets will be available to book from 5pm on Wednesday 1st November. When booking your ticket(s) online you will be asked to make a 50p contribution. This year the School Council have asked for all contributions from our Christmas performances to be split between the Air Ambulance and the Isle of Man Hospice.

This half term we will have two after school sports clubs running. These will be led by an MSR Coach.


