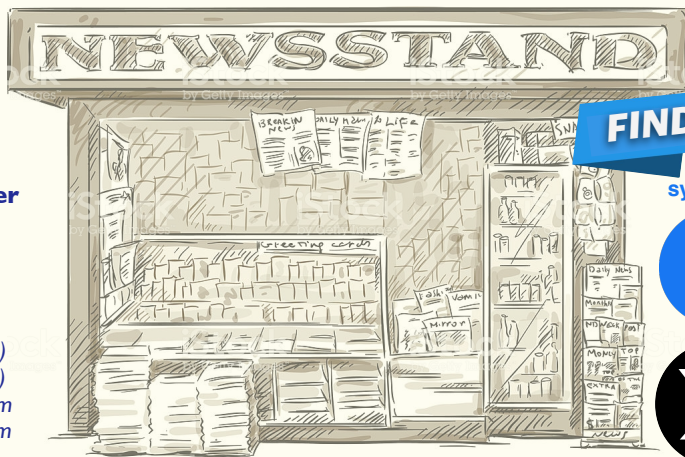

Sports Day will take place at the NSC on Tuesday 9th June, with Yrs 1/2/3 in the morning and Yrs 4/5/6 in the afternoon.

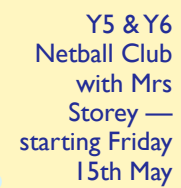
Our Reception children will have their own Sports Day on the school field at the Infant Site on Friday 12th June. Further details will follow in due course.
